

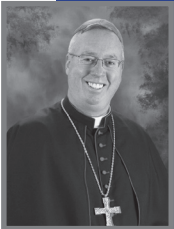
# Inspirational Insights

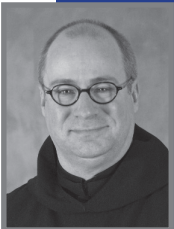
**Bishop Christopher Coyne**  
 Auxiliary Bishop, Apostolic Administrator -  
 Archdiocese of Indianapolis

Bishop Coyne was ordained on March 2, 2011 at St. John Evangelist Church here in Indianapolis and was recently ordained by Pope Benedict XVI as Apostolic Administrator of the Archdiocese of Indianapolis. The Boston native earned a BA in Business Administration from U-Mass Lowell and a Master's of Divinity from St. John's Seminary. He has also received a License for Sacred Liturgy and a Doctorate from the Pontifical Institute of Liturgy at St. Anselmo, Rome. Previously during his service for the Archdiocese of Boston, he was a Director of the Office for Worship and later became the media spokesperson, as the Cabinet Secretary for Communication. Today, Bishop Coyne reaches out to Catholics across social networks through Twitter and Facebook, and through his blog entitled "Let Us Walk Together: Thoughts of a Catholic Bishop."



**Fr. Denis Robinson**  
 OSB, President-Rector - St. Meinrad School of Theology

A Benedictine monk, Fr. Denis is responsible for the priestly formation of men who will serve as priests in dioceses and religious houses across the country and around the world. A Mississippi native, Fr. Denis attended the Catholic University of Louvain, Belgium, where he received a Master's Degree in Theology, a Licentiate in Sacred Theology, and Doctorates in Sacred Theology and Philosophy. Fr. Denis also holds a Bachelor's Degree in Philosophy and Masters of Divinity Degree from St. Meinrad College where he also serves as Assistant Professor of Systematic Theology. Quick with an anecdote or two, Fr. Denis shares his experiences as a monk in today's world.

Pat Koch has been part of the leadership for the world's oldest theme park, Holiday World and Splashin' Safari, since 1960. An Indiana native, Pat and her late husband W.A.
